Called to Order at 6:30 pm

Treasurer's report: Current funds approximately \$2700. We broke even on the bean feed.

We will try to schedule next year's bean feed for the Sunday after Labor Day.

Precinct Caucuses--March 2, 2004:

Minneapolis: at Armatage--Dave Weinlick will head up the planning.

Richfield: at either the intermediate school or high school--Margaret Severe and Doris Rubenstein will head up the planning.

Bloomington: at Kennedy High School--Dottie Gilkeson will head up the planning.

Dave will work on contacting precinct chairs and finding other people to act as convenors for those precincts without chairs.

Discussion of how to do outreach. Ask presidential campaigns who are doing lit drops to pass out our caucus literature? Do our own lit drops? David Miller will try to draft proposed caucus literature by next meeting.

SD63 Convention: Will try to get Richfield Intermediate School for location. Should be scheduled for a Sunday afternoon from 1-4 pm in late March or early April, probably March 28. Need to elect SD63 officers; elect state delegates; and endorsements for house seats.

Discussion of requests for contributions from MYDFL and from State DFL Wall of Honor--Instead of a contribution from our present funds, we will solicit contributions for the MYDFL at the SD63 convention. Most people were not inclined to give significant contribution to the State DFL Wall of Honor.
